Administrative and Civil Litigation

Robert defends clients in regulatory enforcement actions, including matters before the Occupational Safety and Health Review Commission, the Interior Board of Land Appeals, and the California Occupational Safety and Health Appeals Board. He also represents clients in civil litigation following industrial incidents. Robert has litigated disputes relating to oil and gas development, personal injury, groundwater contamination, and breach of contract in state and federal courts across the United States.
